# Internet "History" Slot UKN **\***F

- UKNOF1 took place in central London on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2005
- I'd wanted to do it since 2001, but never expected we'd still be here 5 years and 16 meetings on ☺
- UKNOF was founded by UKIF, but has rather outgrown these beginnings

### **Current Status**



- We have run 16 successful meetings ☺
  -~40-100 attendees each time
- Mailing list of ~650 people
- Programme Committee
- Funding Council
- Committed regular volunteers
- Secure ongoing financial base

### **UKNOF Remit**



#### • From Charter:

- "To pro-actively support the sharing of knowledge, ideas and best practices to enhance the effective, stable and secure operation of the UK's Internet infrastructure as a whole."
- "UKNOF's remit is technical, and any discussion or activities involving commercial, legal or political issues should be limited to where they have a direct impact on technical aspects of network operations."

### **UKNOF** Activities



- "Distribution of clue" ☺
- Meetings 3 times/year
  - Current, interesting, stimulating, relevant sharing of knowledge, experiences and best practices
  - Wider-ranging and less specific remit than other UK Internet bodies
  - OPEN to all, bring in new blood
  - Bring world-class international speakers to UK audience
- Mailing list
  - Mostly announcements

### **Funding Model**



- Non-profit
- We prefer to avoid charging meeting registration fees if at all possible
- In general this has been possible through per-meeting sponsors, but..
- ..relying on solely on vendors can be a bit unpredictable, making meeting logistics difficult
- so we added "subscriber sponsors"..

## **Funding Model**



- Use mixture of vendor and subscriber sponsors
- "subscribers" are various not-for-profit Internet associations with interests in common with UKNOF, comprising the *Funding Council*
- These commit baseline funds which allow meetings to be confirmed well in advance
- Commercial vendors enhance these permeeting where available

– e.g. lunch, nicer venues, beer, curry 🙂

- Invited representatives of sponsors who have contributed significantly to UKNOF
- ..and have made an ongoing support commitment
- We covered our 2009 costs well enough to not need to ask FC for 2010 funds
- Provides degree of governance/oversight for UKNOF

# UKNOF Running Costs UKN **\***F

- Typically about £5k per meeting:
  - venue ~£1.5k
  - catering ~£1.5k
  - admin, misc expenses ~£1500
  - connectivity, webcast
- About 20-25 days/yr Chair's time
  - contributed by ISC, as part of their public benefit remit
  - Keith's day job now Director of Engineering at ISC (only !)
- About 1-15 days/yr Admin time
- We have reserves for around a year of meetings
- Detailed accounts available on request

### **UKNOF Meetings**



- 3 times per year
  - At least one per year in London
  - At least one per year outside London
- Dates are now notionally 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of every Jan, Apr & Sep

- subject to venue etc availability

 We are always looking for hosts/ venues


