- We have run 3 successful meetings ©
  - 40-50 attendees each time
- Mailing list of ~250 people
- Programme committee
  - 11 volunteers
  - ensures supply of interesting presentations
  - provides degree of governance/oversight for UKNOF

### **UKNOF Running Costs**



- Typically about £1k to £2k per meeting:
  - venue ~£1k
  - catering ~£500
  - admin (UKIF) ~£250
  - misc expenses ~£250
  - connectivity
- About 20-25 days/yr Chair's time (voluntary)
- Nominal domain, web & mail list hosting
- Book-keeping
- We have almost exactly broken even so far ⊕





- Three Main Potential Sources:
  - 1. Sponsorship from vendors
  - 2. Meeting registration fees
  - 3. Subscribers
- Idea is to avoid option 2 to grow attendance
  - at least initially
- Vendor sponsors are much appreciated, but there are some practical issues...





- Relying completely on per-event sponsorship creates cash-flow issues
- Difficult to commit to venue (e.g. deposit) until sponsor money in bank
- Means commitment, firm date for meeting, logistics have often been done at last minute
- Commercial sponsors have tended to be concentrated around London, making it difficult to meet Charter's regional meeting remit

# Proposed Improved Funding Model



- Use mixture of vendor and subscriber sponsors
- "subscribers" are various not-for-profit Internet associations with interests in common with UKNOF
- These commit baseline funds for 2006 which allow meetings to be confirmed well in advance
- Commercial vendors enhance these per-meeting where available
  - e.g. lunch, nicer venues, beer ☺

## **Subscriber Sponsors**



- Call for commitment of ~£1k cash or in kind went out to potential sponsors over holidays
  - LINX, LIPEX, Nominet, NWIX, COLT have committed £1k each ©
  - LoNAP £1k, still in discussions
  - UKIF commitment in kind
  - UIXP commitment in kind
  - 2 still to respond
  - 1 has declined

### **UKIF and UKNOF**



- UKIF no longer operates "secretariat" per se
  - Moving UKNOF away from UKIF/Mailbox servers
- For 2006, UKIF becomes a subscriber sponsor like all the others
- UKIF subscription is services in kind:
  - Keith's time as UKNOF Chair
  - Willie's time to do accounts
- Accounting transparency for UKNOF activities

### Keith's Role
