- Established after a request from IPv6 Forum
 - V6 World Congress in Paris (March 2014)



What is UK IPv6 Council?

- Non-profit organisation
- Technology User Group
 - Inspired by Belgium IPv6 Council
- The aim is to:
 - Bring together a community and enable dialog
 - Develop sense of togetherness and share knowledge



Vision

- Create an environment for technical and business people from enterprise/public sector/SP that enables sharing of information, business cases/drivers and experience with IPv6 deployments
- Work with other organisations to make UK IPv6 activities visible in the UK and an international level
- Change perception of the UK as an "IPv6-negative" country




UK IPv6 Adoption



IPv6 Deployment: 21% (Prefixes: 37.41% | Transit AS: 75.23% | Content: 44.93% | Users: 0.19%)

Relative Index: 2.6 out of 10
