


Map showing the Properties

THE NEED FOR BETTER BROADBAND

- Legacy broadband ADSL or Satellite
- ADSL speeds range between no service and 5Mb/s
- No 3g or 4g mobile phone coverage
- •The growing demand from 'The Internet of Things'

WHAT ARE WE DOING ABOUT IT?

- Balquhidder Community Broadband CIC set up 23 June
 2015
- Partnership formed with Bogons Limited for a full FTTP solution - 2015
- De minimis funding package with Community
 Broadband Scotland (CBS) failed with closure of the national Business Voucher Scheme - 2015

WHAT ARE WE DOING ABOUT IT?

- Full funding package from CBS and Stirling Council failed due to legal dispute on process – 2016/17
- Now progressing with 'de minimis' funding from
 Stirling Council and hopefully additional funding from
 a new Business Voucher scheme 2017/18
- Application for the Gigabit Business Voucher Scheme to complete the funding package

HOW ARE WE DOING THIS?

- Self build with community volunteers
- Community provided machinery
- Material purchases cash flowed by Bogons
- Financial investment by Bogons
- 2 Project Officers on job share contracts funded by LEADER and Stirling Council

- 15K of Core Fibre laid
- 38 Properties connected
- Free Wi-Fi hotspot at Stronvar Cabinet
