Sustainability



- UKNOF's reliance on sponsorship has been challenged by industry uncertainty, consolidation, marketing budgets focussed elsewhere
- Meeting costs were increasing, income was decreasing
- New UKNOF Funding Strategy to ensure sustainability by diversifying revenue, including nominal registration charging
 - lowest cost barrier to widest possible audience
 - building enough reserves

Registration Charging



- We have avoided this for as long we could, to make it as easy as possible for everyone to attend
 - continuing this principle as much as we can
 - needed to start charging from UKNOF42
- Complimentary (£0)
 - UKIF Board, AC, PC, Crew
 - Accepted speakers
 - Volunteers from previous meeting
 - Allocated spaces per Partners, Sponsors, Patrons
- Student, Unfunded (£0+)
 - Please do not abuse this!

Registration Charging



- Discounted (£60, £120, £180)
 - 75%, 50%, 25% discount of actual cost-recovery
 - Tiers based on number of space and amount of time until meeting
 - Book early and registration will be less than your travel costs!
 - Not refundable or transferable
- Full Fee (£240)
 - All other attendees from 3 weeks before event
 - Transferable
- On-the-day (£360)
 - All other attendees on day of event

Sustainability



- Attendance numbers for UKNOF42 and 43 are down by about 50% vs 2018 ⁽²⁾
- However, we broke even for both events
 which is vital for UKNOF's future
- Around 22% of this event revenue is from registrations ✓
