Background to Lumison

- ISO9001, Business-class ISP
- Broadband, hosting, networks
- LLU
- VoIP
- Datacentre infrastructure





LUMISUN

UK position

- 3rd party facilities consolidation
- ISPs have limited partnerships
- IP network concentration in Docklands
- Commercial risk, technical risk growing!





Alternatives

- Well known 3rd party facilities out-with London are full / filling up
- ISPs have their own facilities but limited partnerships so far
- Cost of networks perceived as high...
- ...but flexibility is key!





Lumison

- Scottish facility (5 mins from Edinburgh airport – 1 hr flight from London)
- Flexible and extensible (power and cooling)
- 500w/m2, 1000w/m2, and more?
- 5.5kW + racks now being provided

LUMISUN

 Networks into London and Manchester not *that* expensive!





Lumison in London

- Additional facility for clients who want to be within a 2 hr drive of their kit!
- 1kW / m2 cooling
- Dark fibre/managed ethernet into Docklands
- 12k sq ft from Q2 2007

Conclusion

- Docklands filling up, inflexible and expensive
- ISPs could consider build out or partnerships for growth
- Outwith London is of value for DR sites as well as vanilla web hosting
