Where we are now...

- This talk is not about "pandemic vs endemic"!
- Current UK situation is "very relaxed" as all restrictions, including self-isolation if tested positive for COVID, were lifted in February 2022.
 - UK media reported this with their usual balance and sangfroid.
- In spite of this, the "UKNOF crew consensus" is that caution is prudent.
 - Inclusivity: not everyone's (or employers') risk calculus is equal.
- "COVID led our digital transformation" we already had some online participation at all events, but can we do better?



UKNOF in 2020 and 2021

Virtual Events in Response to COVID19

- 2020-01-15 UKNOF45 (London) 8 hours, 14 talks, lunch, Pints'n'Packets
- 2020-05-11 <u>virtualUKNOF</u> 6x ≤15min talks, no breaks
- 2020-07-20 <u>virtualUKNOF</u> 6x ≤15min talks, break, BYO Pints'n'Packets
- 2020-09-07 <u>virtualUKNOF</u> 7x ≤15min talks, break, BYO Pints'n'Packets
- 2020-11-02 virtualUKNOF 6x ≤15min talks, 2 breaks, BYO PnP
- 2021-01-19 <u>UKNOF46</u> (virtual) 9x ~15-30min talks, break + lunch, BYO PnP
- 2021-04-15 <u>UKNOF47</u> (virtual) 7x ≤30min talks, 2 breaks + lunch, BYO PnP
- 2021-08-03 virtualUKNOF 5x ≤15min talks, break, BYO Pints'n'Packets
- 2021-11-18+19 <u>UKNOF48</u> (Manchester) pm+am, 10x ≤30min talks, PnP




NetMcr and NetLdnMonthly "Networking for Networkers"

- UK also blessed with two smaller, less formal, grassroots events
 - Typically 2x ~15 minute talks, with drinks and chat
- NetMcr+NetLdn moved from monthly pub to monthly Zoom
 - Some UKNOF PC members also organise NetMcr/NetLdn
- vUKNOFs were putting on many more lightning talks
 - Consideration given to how vUKNOFs can co-exist, while keeping spirit of each of these events distinct but also thriving
 - Similar total number of talks per year vs in-person UKNOFs



UKNOF48Format Decision

- Venue had already been committed to prior to pandemic (and no longer NHS Nightingale Hospital)
- Vaccination statistics were encouraging
- UKIF Board decided (with support of committees) to hold virtual+physical event
- And manage airborne risk





Hybrid Challenges



Two Years of Virtual Muscles

- UKNOF Programme Committee solicits and reviews talks; supports speakers; shepherds content; produces programme
 - Switch to virtual events wasn't too onerous
- On the day "Event Crew" made of some UKIF Board (legals/etc), some Partners (Bogons and Portfast), PC, CC, and volunteers
 - Switch to virtual changed everything about putting on events
 - A "just-in-time learning experience" (cf. "None of us knew what we were doing, we made it up as we went along")
 - Rehearsals with tech crew, speakers, and session chairs



Two Years of Virtual Muscles

- After 7 virtual events our "virtual muscles" had grown
 - ...but our "in-person muscles" had atrophied
 - ...and now we want to combine the two
 - ...what could possibly go wrong?!
- Who else had experience of running fully hybrid?
 - Could we apply their learning points to our event?
 - Were they doing hybrid pre-pandemic? or now?
 - What challenges might COVID add for us?

Timeline


- Venue was booked for two days
 - We only had morning of first day for on-site setup
- Local volunteers arrived early to build the conference
 - Established networking with venue IT staff and Portfast
 - Worked with venue crew (seating, power, screens, sound)
- Bogons arrived with A/V streaming rig
 - Links in to network, venue screens, venue sound
- Last-chance for rehearsals... soundcheck... showtime!





Zoom centric audience and remote presenters on zoom local presenters fed into zoom



Final A/V Routing






What It Looked Like

 - There are better documents for these requirements



Making automation a core part of the role (as much as possible)


Getting familiar with unit and integration testing (to deploy reliable code)

The Numbers



UKNOF48 vs UKNOF45

- In-person registrations: 122 (vs 155 for UKNOF45 London)
 - In-person attendance: 88 (vs 127 for UKNOF45 London)
 - ~28% no-show (similar to previous free-to-register events)
- Remote participants: over 200 (vs peak 45 streams of UKNOF45)

No reported COVID transmission as a result of the event
