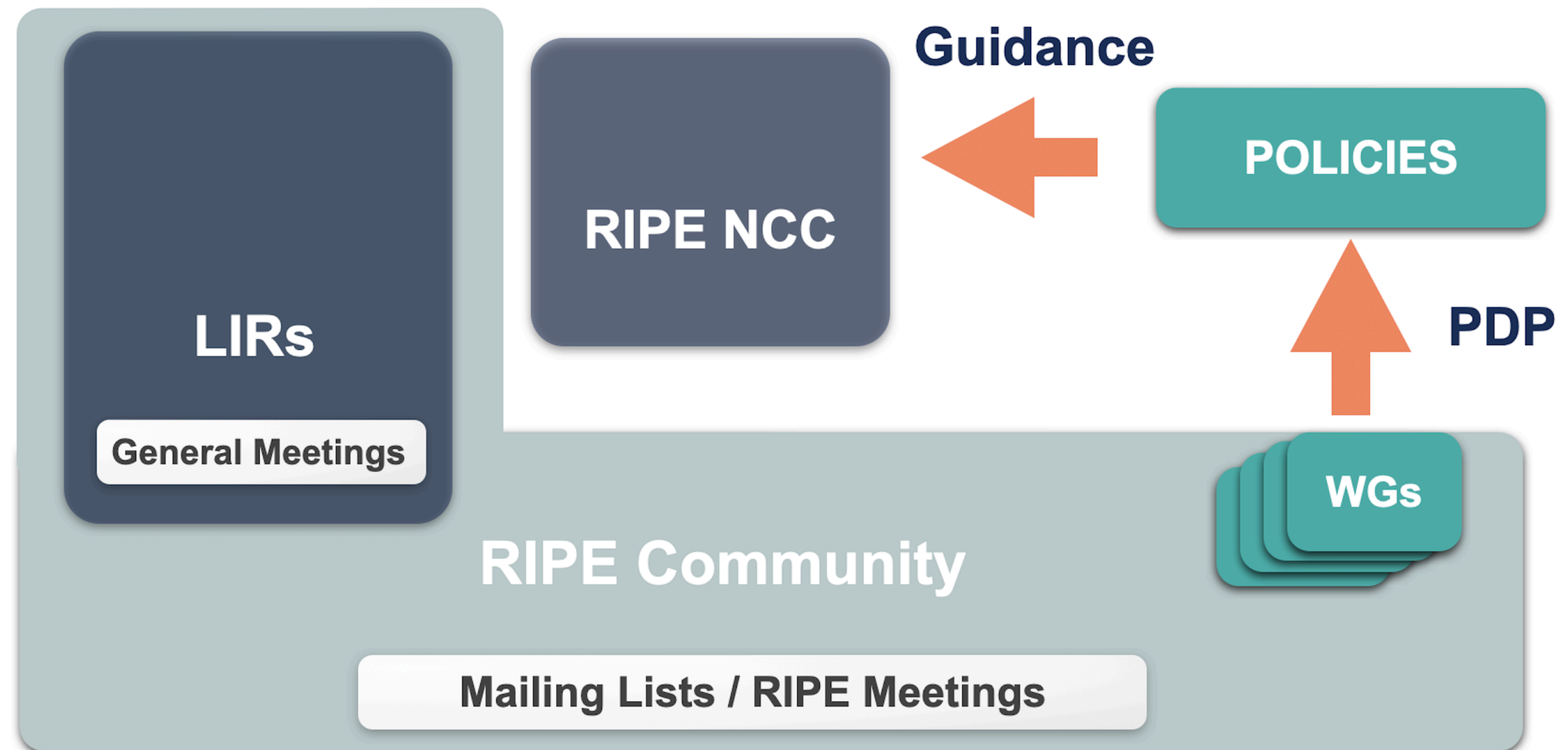

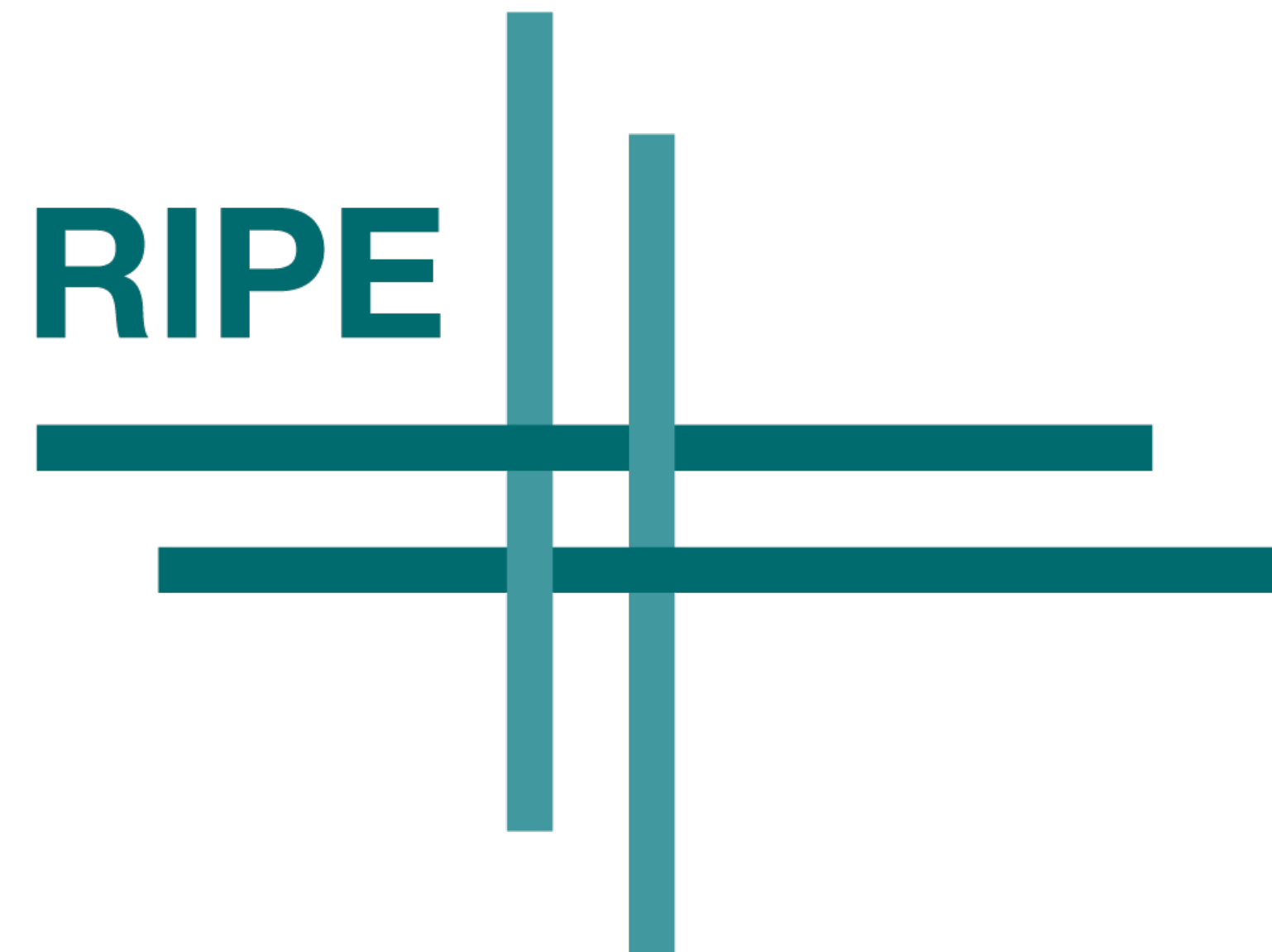

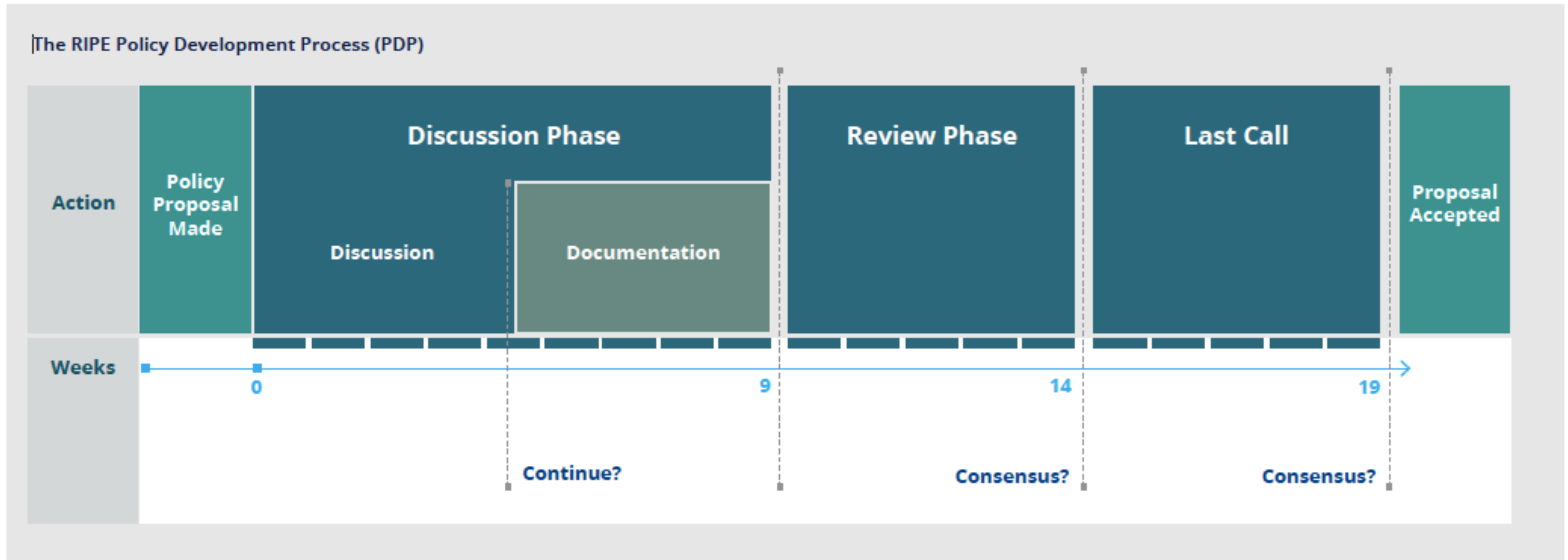

- 2023-02 Minimum Size for IPv4 Temporary Assignments

<b>Assignment minimum size</b>	N/A	/24
<b>Justification size &gt;/24 for research purposes</b>	Utilisation rate	Utilisation rate Routing requirements

## RIPE NCC Services Working Group

- 2023-03 Voluntary Transfer Lock

<b>Discussion Phase</b>	Current EB resolution*	Proposed policy
<b>Implementation period</b>	Temporary (until 1 July 2023)	Indefinite
<b>Lock Application</b>	All holder's resources	Per allocation/assignment
<b>Lock Duration</b>	6 months	6 months + TBD by RIPE NCC

# Numbered Work Items



## RIPE Database Working Group

- **NWIs**

- **NWI 10 - Definition of Country**

- Country attribute in resource holders ORG Objects
- Country code refers to the resource holder legal base
- Country code is reflected in the Extended Delegated Statistics

- **NWI 19 - Change to AS-SET object naming rules**

- New AS-Set must be hierarchical
- Existing non-hierarchical AS-SET can still be updated

- Members and eligible resource holders can run their own Certificate Authority and publish their signed object in RIPE NCC Repositories (“hybrid RPKI”)
